Dewsbike Now Free for Residents

Dewsbury, as the bicycle capital of the nation, receives many visitors who come to enjoy our bicycle track that spans for more than 20km along the Morvale River. Since we hosted the 20th Golden Wheels Cyclist Championship last summer, the number of tourists has been increasing.

This has been affecting Dewsbury residents' access to the public bicycle rental service that we offer. The council has taken into account the residents' complaints and we are happy to announce that we will offer the Dewsbike service without charge to residents.

The new regulation will apply from June 1. Residents will have access to the donated bicycles that do not have a GPS. The existing bicycles with GPS will be rented for the same price, \$15 per 4 hours.

In order to be eligible for the free rental, residents must possess a resident card which they will need to present upon borrowing.
